

## **International Students 2008-2009 Scholarship Competition**

### **International Award of Excellence Scholarship (one award)**

The recipient of this competition will receive **\$10,000 per year** for each year of undergraduate study at MICA in recognition of outstanding artistic achievement and a commitment to pursuing a career in the visual arts.

#### **Eligibility**

To be eligible, candidates must be citizens of a foreign country and be living outside the United States. The scholarship is intended to assist international students seeking to earn their undergraduate degree and are either entering college for the first time or transferring from another college or university abroad. The scholarship award will be applied toward the cost of tuition, fees and books/art supplies. It is estimated that the recipient should be prepared to find funding for an additional \$35,520 per year to pay for living, personal and transportation expenses.

### **C.V. Starr Scholarship (fifteen awards)**

Fifteen students will be selected as recipients of this scholarship, which will award **\$2,500 per year** for four years in recognition of outstanding artistic ability and talent.

#### **Eligibility**

To be eligible, candidates must be citizens of a foreign country, but may be studying either in the United States or abroad. The scholarship is intended for students seeking to earn their first undergraduate degree. The scholarship award will be applied toward the cost of tuition at the Maryland Institute College of Art. It is estimated that each recipient should be prepared to find additional funding for approximately \$43,020 per year to pay for the remaining costs of attendance.

**All eligible applicants will automatically be considered for the CV Starr Scholarship. Be sure to complete all application requirements by February 15<sup>th</sup>.**
