A LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

As we take stock of the past year, it is clear that it will be remembered by the fiscal crisis faced by our country. Despite this economic downturn, MICA continued to enjoy a period of growth and accomplishment. The College can celebrate this achievement because of a strong base, good planning and especially because of your support. By connecting with the vision established by the Board of Trustees almost a decade ago, you have allowed us to become the nation's leading institution for the education of artists.

MICA's ongoing commitment to excellence continued last year with the opening of the Gateway. The first major architectural landmark visible when entering Baltimore from the north on Interstate 83, the award-winning building creates a dramatic entrance to campus while connecting the College to Baltimore's Arts & Entertainment District in the Station North neighborhood.

At the same time, the Gateway's BBOX performance studio and adjoining public gallery have allowed MICA to enhance its connection to the region as an essential destination for cultural and educational programming. The College is host to a dynamic array of events, including 120 exhibitions across campus last year, dozens of lectures by internationally renowned artists and critics, film screenings, performances, concerts, and panel discussions surrounding the role of visual arts in contemporary society.

The College also experienced its strongest fundraising year in recent history, once again reaching the landmark commitment of \$2 million in annual support. This generosity by our donors helps make it possible to achieve our ongoing goals – such as the further development of our graduate programs, which were ranked among the top four out of 220 programs in the visual arts in *U.S. News & World Report's 2008-2010 Best Graduate Schools* edition.

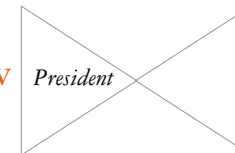
We continue to attract exceptional students. Last year, MICA enrolled 100 percent of the prestigious Presidential Scholars in visual art and photography who selected an art college and was the top producer of Fulbright Fellowship winners among specialty schools. Our alumni continue their long tradition of excelling in their various fields.

For instance, the coveted Janet & Walter Sondheim Prize has been swept by MICA alumni for the past four years, including 2008 winner Geoff Grace '04, and The Baltimore Development Cooperative in 2009, founded by Scott Berzofsky '04, Dane Nester '05, and Nicholas Wisniewski '04. These and other achievements can be connected to the College's ongoing initiatives to strengthen professional development for all of our students. Opportunities to gain real-world experience are woven throughout the curriculum, and the Joseph Meyerhoff Center for Career Development offers programs to assist both students and alumni with employment, grants, awards, residencies, and graduate school admission.

All of these achievements can be connected back to our family of donors - from alumni and faculty to parents and patrons. Whether it's the tie between your gift to MICA and a promising student's ability to attend the College, or between the strength and quality of our programs, faculty, and facilities and that student's growth as an artist, it is your generous support that has made this possible.

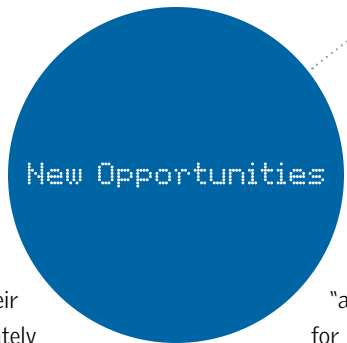
Thank you, and I look forward to working with you as we head confidently into the future.

Fortunately for Tabitha, a graphic design major, her parents respected her decision to pursue a visual arts education and committed themselves to helping her find the best possible school for her.

Both John and Tammy admit that their connection to MICA began with wanting what was right for Tabitha. After experiencing what they called

"a whole new world that opened our eyes to opportunities for our daughter," the Morikises were inspired to forge their own connections.

Carlton Leverette, a ceramicist and professor of art at Baltimore City Community College, says he is "proud of MICA for helping to establish the attitude among students that you must always give your best."

"That's something I always tell my students," he said. "Show your worth, because you never know who's watching or listening."

Since he attended MICA in the 1970s and through his work with the Alumni Council, he has seen MICA's growth. "I'm highly impressed with the leadership and direction," he said. "When I was a student, it was a well-known local college. Now it's one of the top art colleges in the world."

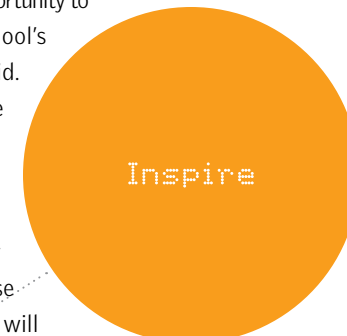
In explaining why he has been a donor for decades, Carlton, who

attended high school just after the Supreme Court ruled against segregation in *Brown v. Board of Education*, recalled the African American tradition of "reaching back and helping others."

What keeps him connected to MICA is "the opportunity to observe the school's progress," he said.

"I want more students to have the opportunity to be trained and inspired by the arts because the experience will enhance skills in other areas – thinking, seeing, writing, speaking. An artist is like a scientist, always observing and digesting. 'Listen,' I tell my students, 'gather all your information and then speak. Or create.' "

Jamie Frailey and Cathy Evans both work as graphic designers, but the fine arts classes they took at MICA continue to influence everything they do, from websites to a walk in the woods.

"MICA enabled me to look at things in a completely new way," said Jamie. "Color, patterns in leaves on trees, composition, light, and shape."

As parents of Morgan Frailey (class of 2012), a fiber major, they see the ways in which a MICA education encourages students to think imaginatively. "These are abilities that can be taken into your life as a whole," said Cathy. "You learn to live more creatively, to take on experiences outside your comfort zone. I think that's key to success in life."

Both Jamie and Cathy are committed to giving as much as they can to MICA. Cathy, who works primarily

with schools and non-profits, said that she has learned from her clients that corporations and foundations look for a high percentage of annual fund participation from alumni and parents before they will contribute to an institution.

Working on the corporate side, with a communications company that does graphic design, Web and venture capital marketing, Jamie has seen the power of big gifts, but noted, "There are fewer resources now. We need lots of people casting seeds."

People often say to us, "you live such a creative life," said Cathy, "and I always reply that anyone can. But I know how lucky we are that MICA encouraged that for us."

IMOGENE DRUMMOND *MFA, Mt. Royal School of Art, 1983*

When Imogene Drummond arrived at MICA's Mt. Royal School of Art in the early 1980s, she was the only person in her class who didn't have a BFA. After graduating with a MSW from Catholic University in Washington, DC, Imogene had been working as a family therapist and taking art classes, but what motivated her to attend MICA was less actual experience as a painter than the desire to be one.

At first, the open studios at Mt. Royal were intimidating and although the environment was designed to invite critiques, no one said anything to her about her work. Imogene was thrilled when a fellow student eventually gave her painting a harsh review. "My work had progressed enough that I could finally be critiqued," she said. "I knew I had finally been accepted as a fellow painter."

Imogene describes her life and work as a "solo journey," which is why she values her connection to MICA and her role as a member of the Alumni Council so deeply. She is eager to add, "You don't have to be wealthy to be a donor. Sometimes situations or opportunities arise that allow people to give who wouldn't normally consider themselves philanthropists."

Calling MICA a "model institution where credit and respect are freely given," Imogene says she gives to the school because it is so dedicated to the growth and development of its students. "Giving to MICA adds meaning to my life."

Timothy App describes the demands the curriculum makes on MICA students as "very high." He added, "they are required to meet them and they do. Many come to us with a strong work ethic, and it is reinforced here."

What prepares them well for the world outside MICA is their "continuing involvement in creative problem solving," he noted. "They don't just develop skills, they are asked to think critically."

Theresa Bedoya calls being at MICA "a transformative experience that allows students to go on and influence culture, communications, and how we see ourselves in an increasingly global world."

Both Theresa and Timothy have been at MICA for many years and are deeply engaged with and committed to the school. Both feel strongly that more funds are

needed for scholarships, so that MICA can offer enough help to the very talented students who want to be here.

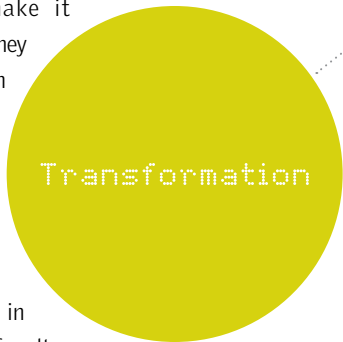
"Parents make incredible sacrifices," said Theresa. "Some students work two jobs to make it happen because they believe it's worth the investment."

According to Timothy, "everyone at MICA has shown a willingness to pitch in in some way. The faculty give as they can because they understand the importance of giving and the need to meet what is a continuing financial challenge."

"The faculty and staff really believe in the students," said Theresa. "The need is more urgent now than ever to support this

school, this place, these people. That's why we choose to give."

Mathias J. "Matt" DeVito was trained as a lawyer and spent many years as head of one of the nation's most forward-thinking organizations, the Rouse Company. Nonetheless, he says, he has never seen anyone work as hard as the students he meets at MICA.

"I'm astounded by the quality of the students' work when they arrive at MICA from high school, but the experience at MICA gives them the opportunity to really grow and they come out different artists than they were when they began," he said.

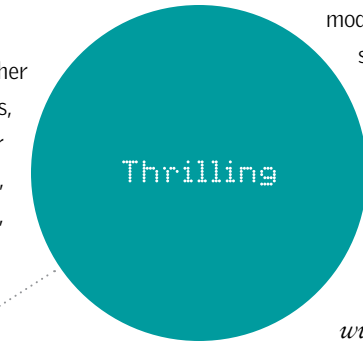
Matt first became connected to MICA through another Rouse Company executive, Edwin A. "Ned" Daniels, who served on the board for more than 30 years. Over the years, through Rouse Company grants to MICA, meetings with Fred Lazarus, and visits to the school, his admiration grew.

When Matt retired from the Rouse Company, the organization offered to start a scholarship in his name, and he chose MICA as the recipient, matching the company's generous gift with his own and endowing the scholarship that bears his name. Since then, the Mathias J. DeVito Scholarship has provided an exceptional incoming freshman with a significant scholarship for his or her four years at MICA.

"I feel that I'm giving to one of the great arts schools," he said, insisting modestly that he is not a patron of the arts, but someone who is simply "interested in painting and painters." He is also clear that "providing an arts education is a very expensive proposition, a constant struggle. MICA needs help in providing that to students, and I want to help bridge that gap."

In a life rich with challenge and experience, Matt says "my involvement with MICA has been one of the highlights."

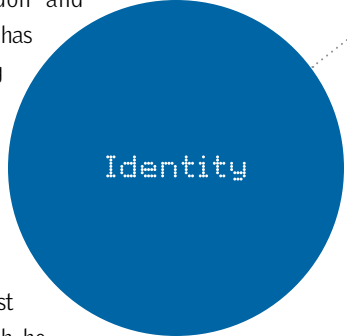
PETER W. BROOKE MFA, Mt. Royal School of Art, 1987

After earning a BFA from a liberal arts college and working in advertising for three years, Peter W. Brooke knew that he wanted to paint. He also wanted to immerse himself in the art world. Peter said that one of his goals was "to meet visual artists and see what they were doing and how their work manifested itself so I could develop a reasonable understanding of my own expectations."

He chose MICA because "there were no limitations on what I could do — video, sculpture, painting, assemblages.... I didn't want a traditional situation where I would be drawing figures all day. The program was vital and changing. It gave me two 'golden years' of experimentation."

Today, Peter is a full-time painter, working on his "meditative landscapes" from his studio in South Royalton, Vermont. Since 1991, he has been showing heavily in both one-person and group shows, primarily on the East Coast, as well as in London and Ireland, where he has had a returning fellowship at the Ballinglen Arts Foundation.

About giving to MICA, he says that it was the first school with which he felt like he had an "identity connection." Living in Vermont, he also "can't physically be a part of what goes on at MICA, but my connections run deep, and giving is one way that I remain connected."

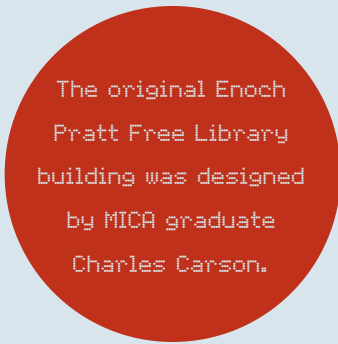

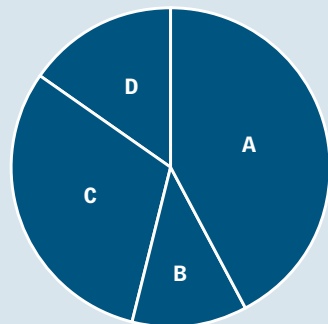

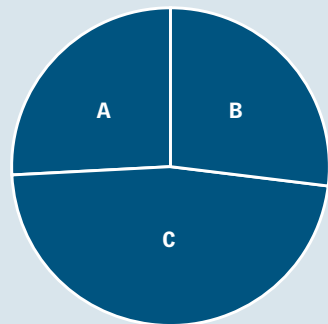
