The Student Activities' staff would like to thank you for your interest in becoming an Orientation Leader (OL) for the 2010-2011 academic year!

The OL position is one of the most critical leadership opportunities on this campus because they are the key players in making orientation a success. This is a high energy, interactive, and enjoyable experience, and we need your complete support and collaboration to make it successful.

As you consider your application, we ask you to keep in mind the following:

- The OL application is due back to Student Activities by **Friday, February 19, 2010**. As you drop it off, **sign up for a group interview session on the clipboard in Student Activities**. There will be three group interview sessions available, but you only need to sign up for one. The three available sessions are **Sunday, February 21st: 1) 9:30am-11:00am, 2) 12:30pm-2:00pm, or 3) 3:00pm-4:30pm**. The group interview session will be the first round of the interview process. If you move on the next phase of the interview process, you will be asked to sign up for an individual interview **during the week of March 1st-5th**.
- The first mandatory program that you will participate in after being selected for the OL position is a **Leadership Retreat on Sunday, April 10, 2010**. This will be from 9am to 5pm, so mark it on your calendars! This is a great way to start building our team this semester and to meet other leaders on campus.
- All OL's are required to attend training prior to orientation. This will necessitate that you return to campus early. Training will take place **Sunday, August 22 – Wednesday, August 25**, and we expect you to be at every session during that week. The typical day during training lasts from **9am – 9pm**, so please do not plan any other activities during this time.
- Orientation for the Fall 2010 semester will begin on **Thursday, August 26, 2010** for New & Transfer Students and continues through **Sunday, August 29, 2010**.

As compensation for being an OL you will receive a cool t-shirt, a \$50.00 gift certificate to the MICA Store, and the opportunity to be a part of the most entertaining group on campus! We cannot emphasize enough how important this position is and how great an opportunity it can be.
