## Weekend Trips

Student Activities organizes weekend trips throughout the year primarily to New York, but also Washington D.C. and Philadelphia. Tickets for NYC and Philadelphia trips can be purchased at the MICA College Store, tickets for the Washington D.C. trip can be purchased at the Student Activities Office . All tickets are available 10 business days prior to each trip. Tickets are non-refundable, but may be independently re-sold to other members of the MICA community.

## Weekend Trip Reservation Policies

Faculty who would like to send a class on a NYC or Philly trip must fill out the *Student Activities Bus Reservation Form* and return it to Student Activities at least **four weeks** prior to the trip. Reservations are made on a first-come first-serve basis. We will hold up to 15 seats for your students until two days before the trip, at which point we make all remaining seats available to the general community for purchase. Due to the high number of reservations, there is a limit of one reservation per faculty, per semester. **Please note the following cancellation policy: There will be a departmental charge of \$100 for cancellations made 15–30 days prior to a trip, and \$200 for cancellations made 0–14 days before a trip.** If these procedures do not meet your needs, or if you would like to arrange for a separate bus trip, Student Activities will be happy to put you in touch with our transportation vendor.

## Special Trips

There are also a number of specialty trips to museums, Six Flags, musicals, theaters, outdoor parks, rock-climbing, and other places of interest. Many of these trips are free for students, but for some there is a nominal ticket price. **Depart Philly:** 5:45 pm – Philadelphia Museum of Art,  
26th Street & Benjamin Franklin Parkway

**Arrive in Baltimore:** Around 7 pm

## Details for New York City Bus Trips

**Depart Baltimore:** 8:00 am – Main Building, 1300 Mount Royal Avenue

**Arrive in NYC :** 12:00 pm – Whitney Museum, 945 Madison Avenue at 75th Street

**Check in at Bus:** 6:45 pm – SOHO, northwest corner of Houston and Broadway

**Depart NYC:** 7:00 pm – Bus leaves promptly at 7:00 pm, late students will be left!

**Arrive in Baltimore:** Around 11:00 pm  
Commons, 120 McMechen Street  
Meyerhoff House, 140 W. Lafayette Avenue  
Main Building, 1300 Mount Royal Avenue

If traffic and/or time allows, the bus makes one 15-20 minute stop on the New Jersey Turnpike in each direction for the bathroom and snacks. This usually occurs around Exit #3.
